



## **BAISIS Code of Conduct**

The aims of BAISIS are:

- To promote the welfare of international students in British schools and colleges
- To share best practice with colleagues on issues regarding the pastoral and academic development of international students
- To enable school and colleges to help international students to realize their full potential
- To preserve the ideal of a quality introduction to British school life through an initial induction in a specialized centre or group
- To ensure excellence of provision through peer evaluation and collaboration with outside bodies

Members of BAISIS agree to the following:

- To disclose any personal and professional commitments which may be seen as conferring unfair advantage upon an individual or an institution
- To share information and knowledge with other members in a professional spirit, mindful of the Competition Act of 1998
- Not to break a contract signed by themselves with another school
- Not to attempt to influence a person to break a contract signed with another school
- Not to use knowledge gained at another school to attempt to dissuade individuals or institutions from using that school
- To respect intellectual property
- That the transfer of students between member schools will be handled with openness and with the best interests of the student as paramount
- To ensure that all aspects of BAISIS will be able to stand the test of scrutiny by other schools, auditors and professional associations.

Any breach of this code of conduct will be considered by the BAISIS Committee.
